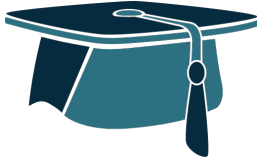
### VISION

*Education and Health*

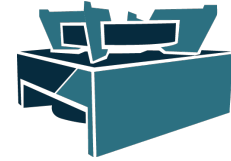
To nourish the souls, minds and bodies of vulnerable populations by supporting quality education and promoting human health.

## Miracle Grow

This amazing grass is starting to transform the landscape in areas that can often be low yielding for farmers.



In many parts of Western Kenya, the soils are acidic and in need of soil amendments or fertilizer. These can often be expensive or unavailable to farmers. A previously underutilized

grass is now making a huge difference in the region without any soil additions!

Brachiaria grass is growing well in the poor soils, and it produces a large volume of material in a relatively short amount of time.

The grass improves milk production in local dairy cows, which allows these individuals in turn to sell the excess milk their families do not utilize.

Rhoda is also able to split and sell Brachiaria seedlings from her plot, spreading the grass to other farmers and gaining income from the sales.
